In 2018 he established and is the current director of the IRTA International Intestinal Failure Registry (IIFR), a world-wide platform to study pediatric intestinal failure. His research work is within the fields of intestinal failure, GI transplantation and congenital diarrhea. Dr. Avitzur published more than 130 papers in prominent journals and textbooks.
