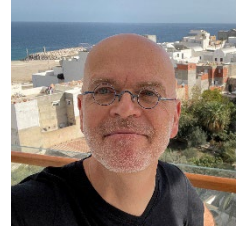


Christophe Chardot

Christophe Chardot is a pediatric and transplant surgeon. He was trained in Paris (Hôpital Bicêtre), Brussels (Cliniques Universitaires Saint Luc), Birmingham UK (Queen Elizabeth and Birmingham Children's Hospitals). He worked then in Paris, Brussels, Birmingham(UK) and Geneva. Since 2009, he has been working in Hôpital Necker-Enfants malades (Paris) as surgical head of the pediatric transplantation for abdominal organs (liver, intestine, multivisceral, and kidneys) , also in charge of pediatric hepato-biliary surgery, intestinal rehabilitation, and vascular surgery. He has launched a collaboration programme between Assistance Publique- Hôpitaux de Paris and the University Hospital of Monastir (Tunisia) for the development of a pediatric liver transplantation programme in Tunisia. With the surgical NGO "La Chaîne de l'Espoir" and the Hôpital Mère Enfant de Bingerville (Ivory Coast), he has been helping for the development of reference center for the treatment of children with oesophageal caustic burns in Western and Central Africa.



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
