He has published more than 350 peer-review and invited manuscripts and co-authored the only four books on pediatric gastrointestinal motility. He has served as President of the North American Society for Pediatric Gastroenterology Hepatology and Nutrition (NASPGHAN) and has held leadership positions within ANMS (council member and secretary), AGA (chair of the GDCH section), Brain-Gut Club, American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and American Board of Pediatrics (ABP). He has chaired both the Rome III and Rome IV Child-Adolescent committees and currently co-chairs one of the Rome V committees. He has received the Master Award in Gastroenterology by the AGA, the IFFGD Clinical Research in Pediatrics Award, the Rome Foundation/Torsoli Foundation Award, and the NASPGHAN Shwachman Award.
