Dr Lisa Mellon is a health psychologist and humanistic psychotherapist, and a lecturer in the School of Population Health in the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland. As a medical educationalist she teaches health behavior change theory and communication skills with undergraduate medicine, physiotherapy and pharmacy. As a researcher, she holds a Cochrane Fellowship and recently published a Cochrane Review on interventions for increasing immunosuppressant medication adherence in solid organ transplant recipients. Lisa has expertise in systematic reviews of behavioural interventions in a number of different health conditions, including organ transplantation, stroke, heart failure, medication adherence and smoking cessation, and is a grant holder on projects examining barriers and facilitators of medication adherence post-organ transplant, and quality of care for people with end stage renal failure. She is currently the Research Lead for the Irish Kidney Association.
