I work as Liver/gastrointestinal transplant surgeon at Miami Transplant Institute (University of Miami Jackson Health System). I graduated from University of Hacettepe school of medicine in Ankara, Turkey in 1993. After few years in thoracic surgery residency in Turkey, I moved into USA and continued my career. I did all my general surgery training at University of Miami/ Jackson health System and graduated from general surgery residency program in 2005. I completed 3 years postgraduate fellowship training in abdominal transplantation here at Miami Transplant institute and have been a faculty since 2008. I also worked two years with the transplant team before my residency as an intensive care fellow for transplantation from 1998 to 2000. Miami transplant institute is one the the largest transplant programs in USA. I perform both adult and pediatric liver and intestinal, multivisceral transplantations at the program. I also perform surgeries for liver and abdominal malignancies in both adult and pediatric patient population. I did a significant amount of animal research in uterus transplantation. I am currently teaching faculty at University of Miami Miller school of Medicine.
